Hello friends, my name is Kachi and I'm an archaeologist. I came from Whashington State University in the USA to discover what life was like for Chanka warriors.

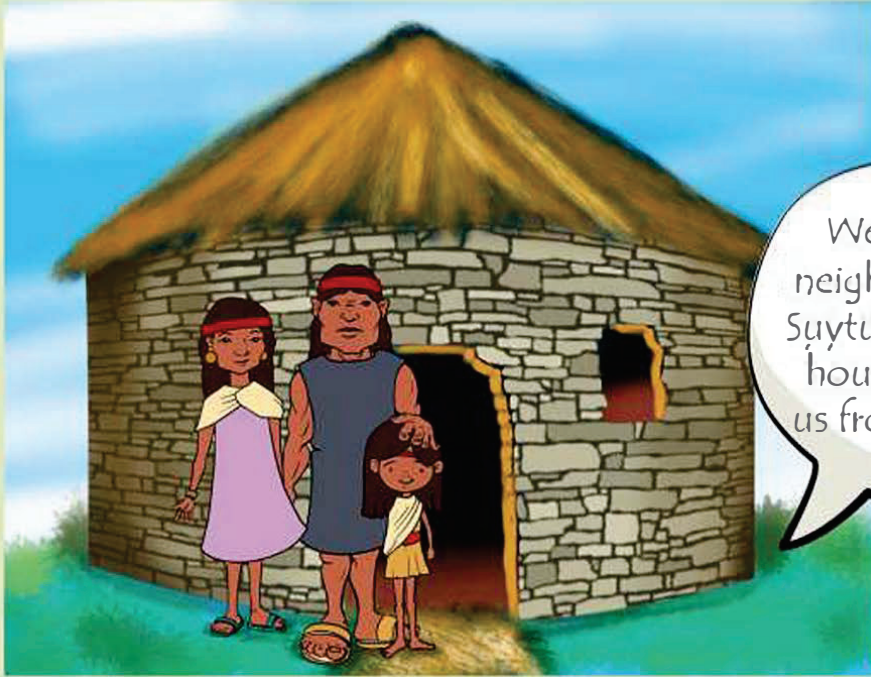
In the heights of Sondor...

This is Yaju and his job is to shepard our alpacas, and farm the land.

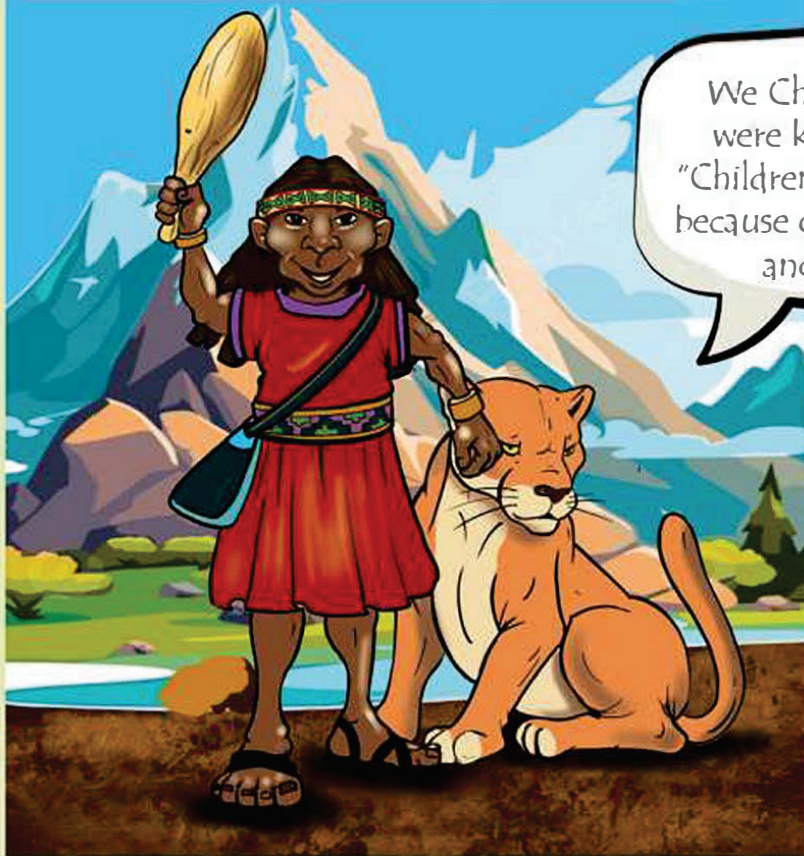


Laguna Pacucha is very important to us because it provides water

We worship these mummies, because they are our grandparents.



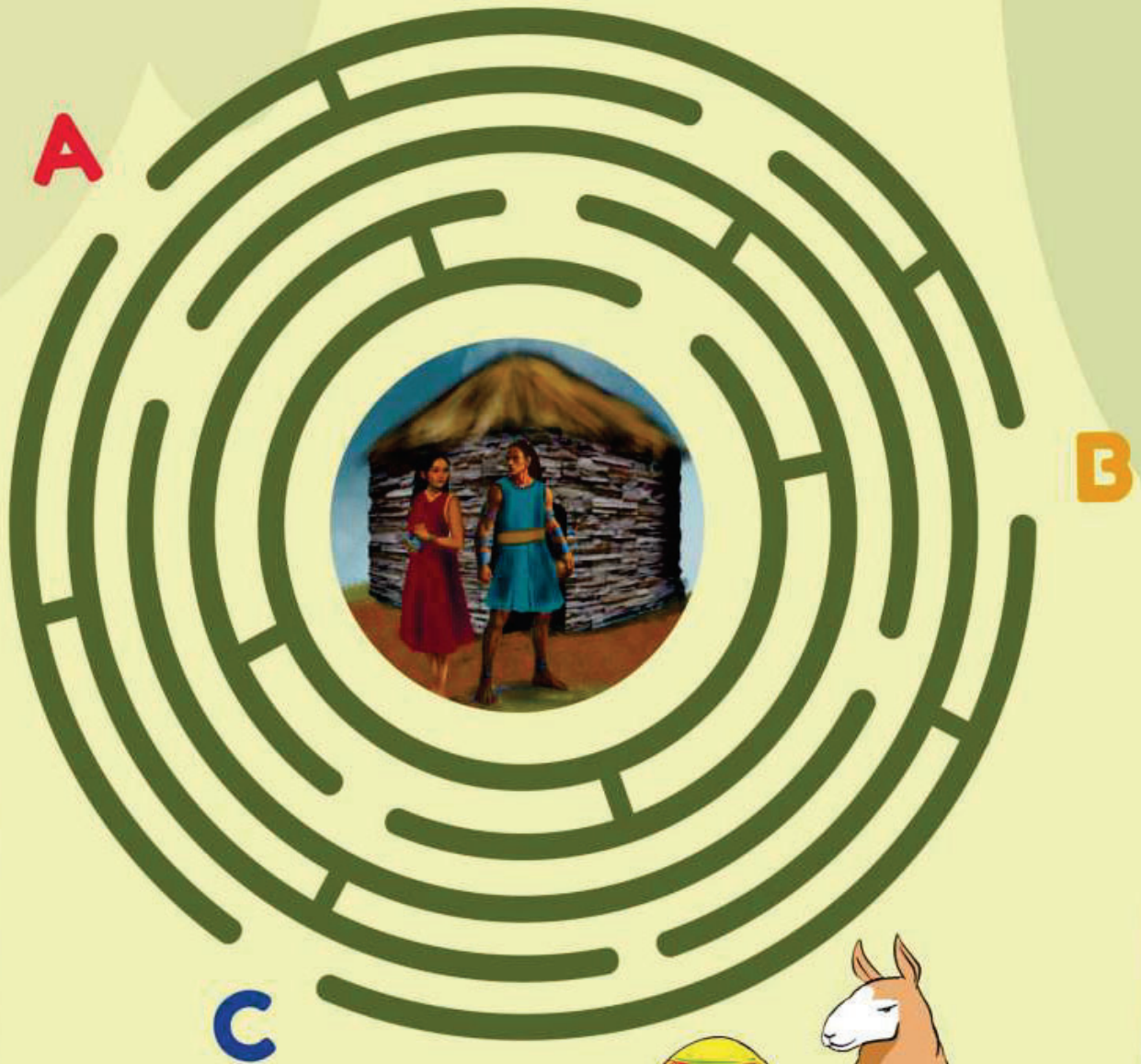
Long after our passing, the archaeologists came and started to excavate our houses, temples, and cemeteries so that we could tell the story of our history.
